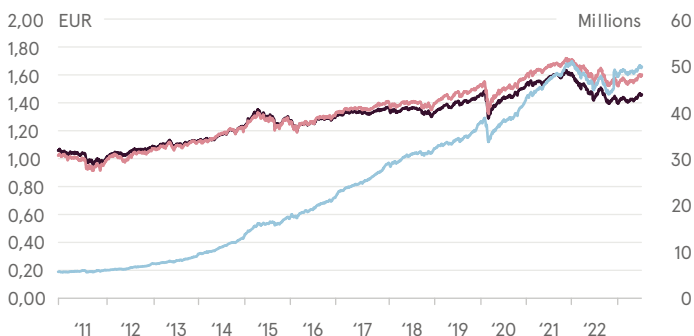
Fund description

It is a medium-risk fund with up to 50% of its assets invested in equity markets. It has a global exposure to equities, with a more stable long-term return compared to sector or regional funds. The remainder (at least 50%) is mainly invested in bonds of investment-grade euro-area governments and corporates, or bond funds. Designed for participants seeking balanced returns and risk. Recommended for 50-58 year olds.

Fund manager's commentary

Second quarter proved to be even better in terms of performance mainly due to developed market equities. Risk assets were not discouraged by restrictive monetary policy. Due to rising interest rates government bond yields rose, especially in short term debt, which suppressed price appreciation. Despite weak macroeconomic data corporate balances remained stronger than expected. This resulted in high yield fixed income outperformance relative to investment grade corporates. Bond volatility started trending down, as measured by the MOVE index, after levels not seen since the global financial crisis in the first quarter.

The shares and weightings of the fund's benchmark index are selected in accordance with the investment strategy set out in the rules of the fund, but the fund manager may make investment decisions at his own discretion.
